THE ODYSSEY FOR PENELOPE



ΟΔΥΣΣΕΙΑ ΤΗΣ ΠΗΝΕΛΟΠΗΣ

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Ι αρουσιάζουμε ένα πρότζεκτ, «γεννημένο» μέσα από μία δημιουργική έμπνευση που πραγματοποιήθηκε το 2014. Η χρονιά αυτή συμβολίζει την ανάμειξη πολιτισμών της Ρωσίας με την Ελλάδα. Η ιδέα αυτή εξελίχθηκε μέχρι σήμερα, μέσα από την προσπάθεια όσων συμμετείχαν σε αυτήν και έφτασε να ονομάζεται «Οδύσσεια της Πηνελόπης». Γιατί Οδύσσεια; Δεν είναι μόνο ένας ευθύς συσχετισμός με την ιστορία της Ελλάδας, η οποία έχει «βαφτιστεί» παγκοσμίως ως η «μητέρα του πολιτισμού και της ακαδημαϊκής εκπαίδευσης που ακμάζει στις μέρες μας σε Ρωσία και Ευρώπη. Για μας η Οδύσσεια δεν συμβολίζει απλώς μία περιπέτεια. Αντιθέτως πρόκειται για ένα σύμβολο παγκόσμιας αναζήτησης της σύγκρισης νοοτροπιών διαφορετικών λαών σε σχέση με εμάς. Η ιδέα αυτή μας παροτρύνει να ανακαλύψουμε κάποιες διαφορετικές πλευρές της καθημερινής απλότητας.

Οδύσσεια είναι ο δρόμος για το οικείο, ο γυρισμός του ανθρώπου στον εαυτό του, στην ελευθερία του που τον γέννησε και γεννήθηκε μέσα από την αρχαία Ελλάδα. Ένα απίστευτο συναίσθημα που σε κάνει να νιώθεις μέρος του κόσμου αυτού και μας δίνει ώθηση να συνεχίσουμε την προσπάθεια μας.

Σε αντίθεση με την μυθική Πηνελόπη, η οποία περίμενε πιστά τον δικό της Οδυσσέα, εμείς, μία καινούρια έκδοση αυτής, ανακαλύψαμε την ομοιότητα μεταξύ μας και φτιάξαμε μία δική μας περιπέτεια, διαφορετική. Μία περιπέτεια μέσα από την οποία παλέψαμε για την διαφοροποίηση της γνώμης σχετικά με την αδυναμία της γυναικείας φιλίας.

Είμαστε όλοι διαφορετικοί και συνάμα διαθέτουμε όμοια στοιχεία. Σεβόμαστε την δημιουργικότητα των συναδέρφων μας και υποστηρίζουμε ο ένας τον άλλον σε όλη αυτή την περιπέτεια. Ελπίζουμε λοιπόν σε όλους τους κατάλληλους πόρους για να μπορούμε να προχωράμε την ιδέα μας εσαεί. 🔟
